

**Minutes of the Executive Committee of Deacons
Central Baptist Church of Fountain City
February 14, 2010**

Welcome – Chairman Terry Hicks welcomed the deacons to the meeting. Susanne Burnette led the deacons in a devotion and prayer.

Information Exchange - David Renfro was recognized from the Administration Council. He stated that the council was working on the following items:
