# Annual Business Meeting

At the start of worship this Sunday, we will hold a short business session to vote on next year's budget, officers, and committees. The detailed handout is available at the sanctuary entrances and was reviewed last Sunday at the info session.

The motions to be voted on are:

- The Budget, Finance, and Stewardship Committee along with the Administrative Council recommend approval of the 2024-25 budget as outlined on the handout.
- The Trustees and Administrative Council recommend the CBCFC Ministry Endowment earnings be used to support families in our Weekday Education Program with tuition hardships.
- The Nominating Committee recommends Central Baptist elect the committee members, nominees, and committee chairs for the Budget, Finance, and Stewardship Committee, Personnel Committee, and the Properties, Buildings and Grounds Committee as listed on the handout.
- The Nominating Committee recommends Central Baptist elect the Officers listed on the handout.
- The Deacons recommend Central Baptist elect the Trustees as well as the Chair and Vice Chair of Trustees/Administrative Council, as listed on the handout.
