

From Your Pastor

I remember a highlight from Mr. Roger's Neighborhood where Mr. Rogers reflected on how he felt when scary things happened in the world.

He said, "When I was a boy and I would see scary things in the news, my mother would say to me, 'Look for the helpers. You will always find people who are helping."

Over the last couple of weeks, we have seen images of much suffering due to Hurricane Helene, but we have also seen many helpers.

Throughout the mountains of Western North Carolina, numerous individuals and communities have become isolated and trapped because of collapsed bridges and roads.

Private planes from all over the Southeast have been volunteering to fly donated supplies to small airports in the hills. They have flown for hours and hours on end. One Army pilot remarked over the radio that the Ashe County Airport was busier than flying into Newark International Airport. They usually get just one or two planes a day. Since the storm, they have gotten sixty or more. All these flights have been relief efforts.

Aircraft have been used to deliver supplies, pick up people needing rescue, drop off firefighters and search-and-rescue crews, and request assistance for others who can be more easily accessed from the ground. Due to the terrain, helicopters have been quite helpful, as well.

One pilot reflected, "I am in real estate. This is not my job," Reeves said. "I'm more than happy to do it, just because of the situation." This is what helpers do in times of need.

Pray for the victims of these recent hurricanes; commit to help where you can; be generous in your giving; and don't forget to pray for the helpers, too.


