Fountain City Ministry Center Update

The FCMC is grateful for your partnership this past year. In 2024, we served 2,337 families with bags of food and hygiene items, and 679 children with clothing. We provided 149 coats for children and helped 5 single working moms with car repairs so they could keep their jobs. In addition, we helped 44 individuals with other pressing needs (KUB assistance, gas, athletic fees for students, etc.). We served 175 children at our annual "Back to School" event.

In 2025, we wish to continue with our auto repair assistance. There will be money set aside to partner with our local schools for special needs children, and money to assist with the rising needs of the unhoused population in Fountain City.
