# From Your Youth Pastor

Over the last couple of months in Life on Wednesday nights, we have been going through a series on questions. Questions about God, about Scripture, about how God interacts with us and the world. I hope it has been as helpful for our students as it has been for me.

The main reason that I chose to do this series is to show students that it is okay to ask questions; that God is not afraid of our questions, nor does He look on us in disappointment when we have questions. It is one thing to know facts about God, to recite Bible passages and know the right answers to some questions, but I have found in my life that those things are not sufficient to sustain my walk with Christ. Instead, I had to let my questions lead me, not to right answers, but to the beauty of a God who is bigger and better than anything we can imagine. Whose love and grace know no end. And who invites us into the lifelong pursuit of following after Him.
