

From Your Pastor

We are only a week away from the Celebration of Easter. I hope you are preparing for worship and paying close attention to God's love for the world as demonstrated through Jesus.

A friend of mine used to be a pastor but has been out of vocational ministry for several years. Some time ago, I asked him what he missed about his previous role. On Easter morning, we welcome people in worship whom we do not see as often. Will you rejoice in their presence and be thankful for God's work in their lives?
