I once traveled to Detroit to help a church beginning its singles ministry. My contact informed me that the group included both church members and friends, many of whom had no previous connection to faith. He advised me to "be ready to share my faith when appropriate."

On Saturday morning, we set out for the art museum. While we were traveling in the van, one of the participants asked, "If you could sum up the Bible in one sentence, what would it be?"

My response was, "God is faithful." Throughout the day, she and I engaged in conversation about what "God is faithful" truly means. She was quite the seeker.

So, where does God's faithfulness begin? Evidence of this can be seen at creation, where God forms something from nothingness, brings order out of chaos, and breathes life into people.

For God so loved the world...

As we celebrate Jesus' Resurrection today, we recognize the opportunity to receive life through Him. God's faithfulness continues.
